- Resident question Modifying covenant Covenants cannot be changed until 2032. Clarification provided business logos on personal vehicles are not currently allowed. Can cover with magnetic sign, at low cost, if outside of garage.

Approval of the Minutes: The March minutes were approved unanimously.

Treasurer's Report: The Board reviewed the monthly income, expenses, and balances for March 2023, as presented by Mark Meihaus. The CD deposit has been completed.

Dues Report: Presently 410 (54%) of households have paid their annual CKS/E HOA dues compared to 442 (58%) last year. Membership reminder cards will be delivered in the next month.

Special Events:

- Easter Event Well attended 150-200 residents. Easter Bunny was popular. Ran out of Food. Coloring contest winners were selected, with prizes to be awarded. Identified some recommendations for next year.
- Movie Nights In progress now, due to rescheduling of West Laurel Park construction. Plan family friendly movie on a Friday night, once/month – June, July and August. Dates – TBD. Looking at potential sponsorships, grants to help with costs. Food options – TBD. Dani will check on possible food trucks.
- Parks Beautification Day April 22nd at 9:30 a.m.
- Board expressed great appreciation for work of the Special Events committee, who are volunteers.

Covenant Violation Updates:

- Potential violations are being monitored, with notifications sent for identified violations.
- Reminder will be included in the Scroll boats, RVs
- Clarification provided When violation cannot be addressed timely, residents can notify Board of status/plans to resolve issue. i.e. delay in getting a contractor, etc

Volunteer opportunities are available to help identify potential violations.

COHOPE: Presentation on Fentanyl and Narcan provided by Jeffco Health Department representative. Information provided on House Bill 23-213, regarding changes to planning/zoning authority (state/county). Information will be included in the scroll. Old/Backlogged Business:

- Replacement of Blockworker Captain in process.
- Recruitment Chairperson for the Board election process in process. Dani will serve as Membership Chairperson.
- New contract perimeter maintenance Approved, with 2 members abstaining.
- Guest authors for Scroll articles Walt Barnhart, Scroll Editor, followed up with one and had no response.
- Web-site updates: In progress. One year licensing rights have been purchased to continue operation of current site.
- SmartWeb Project Request Action Plan Project requests are now scanned into SmartWeb for recordkeeping.

New Business:

- Neighbors Helping Neighbors initiative Initiative will be discontinued.
- Request for \$180 unanimously approved for graphic designer for new logo/branding, based on previously approved draft. Tom will work with designer to prepare several versions for review/approval at the next meeting.
- Request unanimously approved for a \$300 discretionary fund for the HOA President, allowing expenses to be reimbursed without prior Board approval.
- Brandon will check with the attorney regarding any requirements for sending covenants to realtors, with listings in the neighborhood. (Tracking issues resident name/address is not included on the certified letter receipt.)
